Authorizing a Lease Agreement With St. Lawrence Seaway RSA Cellular Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless for Use of Tower Space at the Public Safety Building Radio Transmission Tower

By Legislator:
Whereas, Jefferson County owns and operates a radio transmission tower at its Public Safety Building complex in the City of Watertown, and
Whereas, St. Lawrence Seaway RSA Cellular Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless (hereinafter "Verizon") has proposed to lease space on said tower for its private proprietary use and to make structural modifications to said tower in order to support the additional weight of new equipment at no expense to the County, and
Whereas, Verizon has agreed to pay an annual lease payment of \$25,500.00 with a one time signing bonus of \$2,000.00 with an initial lease term of five years. The lease shall be renewable for an four (4) additional five (5) year extensions. The lease payment shall increase to 110% of the annual lease amount for the prior term at the beginning of each new five year extension period, and
Whereas, The Tower has the required space for the Verizon equipment and with structural improvement will support said equipment and all necessary County equipment without interference with County operations, and
Whereas, The partnership of public and private resources will benefit the taxpayer as well as Verizon customer, therefore the Board of Legislators supports the above proposal and authorizes a lease upon such terms.
Now, Therefore, Be it Resolved, That the Chairman of the Board is hereby authorized and directed to execute a lease with St. Lawrence Seaway RSA Cellular Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless upon the aforesaid terms, and such further documents as may be necessary to effectuate said purpose, subject to the approval of the County Attorney as to form and content.

Whereas, Article 27 of New York State Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation Law establishes a mechanism for allocating funds to local governmental sponsors for the development and maintenance of snowmobile trails designated as part of the State Snowmobile Trail System, and
Whereas, Having reviewed the criteria contained in 6NYCRR, Section 617.7, Jefferson County finds that there will be no significant adverse environmental impact resulting from the digital update, minor reroutes, and addition to the snowmobile trails though Jefferson County, and
Whereas, Jefferson County Board of Legislators passed Resolution No. 44 of 2018, establishing an annual budget for funds awarded from New York State Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation for maintenance services to be performed by each snowmobile club pursuant to an annual agreement governed by program requirements, and
Whereas, It is the County's intent to support the development and maintenance of snowmobile trails as an important economic and recreational resource for Jefferson County, and
Whereas, An Environmental Assessment Form (EAF) has been completed which reviews potential environmental impacts and determines that no significant impacts will occur.
Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved, That Jefferson County shall assume lead agency status for this action pursuant to SEQR and has determined that this is an unlisted action and will not have any adverse environmental impacts, and be it further

Authorizing Conveyance of Unused County Highway Land in the Town of Brownville to David M. Greenizen

in the Town of Brownville to David M. Greenizen
By Legislator:
Whereas, Jefferson County acquired certain real property in the Town of Brownville for highway purposes, and which real property was a part of old New York State Route 180 (also referred to as S.H. 1182), and
Whereas, Pursuant to the State of New York Department of Public Works Official Order Number 1036 dated January 28, 1965, the State of New York Department of Public Works thereafter maintained said portion of old New York State Route 180, in connection with a road project realigning a portion of said highway, and
Whereas, Upon realignment of said portion of highway having been completed, and pursuant to State of New York Department of Public Works Official Order Number 1086 dated May 27, 1965, the State of New York Department of Public Works rescinded Official Order Number 1036, and resulting in the aforesaid property becoming unused land unnecessary for highway purposes, and
Whereas, Highway Law §118-a, provides for the disposition by the County of unused and unnecessary highway property upon the recommendation of the County Highway Superintendent, by the abandonment and conveyance of such land to the abutting owners, and
Whereas, The Jefferson County Highway Superintendent has recommended the abandonment and conveyance of a portion of old New York State Route 180 as identified and described in the attached description and map, to the abutting owner, David M. Greenizen, and
Whereas, David M. Greenizen has requested that the portion of the aforesaid unused highway property, abutting his property at Tax Map No. 72.00-2-12.5 in the Town of Brownville be conveyed to him.
Now, Therefore, Be it Resolved, That said portion of unused county highway property in the Town of Brownville be conveyed by quit claim deed to the abutting land owner, David M. Greenizen, pursuant to Highway Law §118-a, said property conveyed is identified and described in the attached description and maps incorporated as a part of this resolution by reference, and said property is declared unnecessary for highway purposes and is hereby abandoned, and be it further
