SUBJECT: Jefferson County 100 Gallon Prover

On February 8, 2019 state specialist 1 Mike Konyak gave a presentation to Jefferson County weights & measures that was mandated by the New York State Weights & Measures director Mike Sikula. The subject was the criteria and safety that the state is requiring for current field provers that are being used to test fuels such as distillates and gasoline.

Upon completion of the presentation Mr. Konyak performed an examination of both the Jefferson County and Lewis County 100 gallon provers to determine if the provers meet the criteria for safely testing flammable fuels such as gasoline, aviation fuel, and jet fuel A.

After examining the Jefferson County 100 gallon prover it was determined that there were a number of issues that would <u>prevent</u> the prover to be used in testing <u>any</u> flammable fuels.

- There is no grounding cable.
- There is no bonding cable.
- There is no bottom fill tube to reduce gasoline vapor.

The first two issues regarding the grounding cables can be addressed but the required bottom fill tube **CANNOT** be corrected. It would require adding the fill tube and the state will not certify any prover that has been altered in any way.

After examining the Lewis County 100 gallon prover it was determined that the only issue is the lack of the bottom fill tube.

With the 100 gallon provers not being able to test flammable fuels means there are at least 23 total meters that cannot be certified in both Jefferson and Lewis County. Due to the listed shortfalls of our current prover we can no longer safely test the fuel trucks at the Watertown Airport.

There is another issue to take into consideration. Every five years the state requires all of our testing equipment to be taken to the metrology lab in Albany to be recertified, this includes the 100 gallon prover. The prover is due to be certified again in 2020. After the last certification (it's a story by itself...) I am very doubtful that our current prover will be certified in 2020.

Given all these newly developed circumstances I am requesting that Jefferson County consider the purchase of a new mobile 100 gallon prover system replacing our current 60 year old prover.

Responded to callers, emails, and walk-ins with requests concerning flood maps, zoning, election districts, and county map viewer.


