Authorizing the Implementation and Funding in the First Instance 100% of the Federal Aid and State "Marchiselli" Program Aid Eligible Costs of a Transportation Federal-Aid Project (Noble Street over West Creek), and Appropriating Funds Therefor

Whereas, A Project for the Replacement of Noble Street over West Creek, PIN 775377 (the "Project") is eligible for Funding under Title 23 U.S. Code, as amended, that calls for the apportionment of the costs of such program to be borne at the ratio of 80% Federal funds and 20% non-federal funds, and

Whereas, The County of Jefferson desires to advance the Project by making a commitment of 100% of the non-federal share of the cost of Preliminary Engineering and Right-of-Way Incidentals Phases of the Project, and

Whereas, The County has allocated funding to this project through the Adopted 2019 Budget.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved, That the Jefferson County Board of Legislators does hereby approve the Project, and be it further

Resolved, That the Jefferson County Board of Legislators hereby authorizes the Jefferson County Treasurer to pay in the first instance 100% of the federal and non-federal share of the cost of the Preliminary Engineering and Right-of-Way Incidentals Phases of the Project or portions thereof, and be it further

Resolved, That the sum of \$195,000, which includes the Preliminary Engineering and Right-of-Way Incidentals Phases of the Project, or so much thereof as is necessary is hereby appropriated from Account 20511300 02904 in the 2019 County Budget, and made available to cover the cost of participation in the above phase of the Project, and be it further

Resolved, That in the event the full federal and non-federal share of the costs of the project exceed the amount appropriated above, the Jefferson County Board of Legislators shall convene to appropriate said excess amount immediately upon the notification by the Chairman of the Jefferson County Board of Legislators thereof, and be it further

Resolved, That the Chairman of the Jefferson County Board of Legislators be and is hereby authorized to execute all necessary Agreements, certifications or reimbursement requests for Federal and/or Marchiselli Aid, subject to the approval of the County Attorney as to form and substance, on behalf of the County of Jefferson with NYSDOT in connection with the advancement or approval of the Project and providing for the administration of the Project and the municipality's first instance funding of project costs, and permanent funding of the local share of federal-aid and state-aid eligible Project costs and all Project costs within appropriations

2019 CDBG Housing Award Guidelines - Summary

- This grant was awarded for larger projects that will require more resources to address the problems that
 are identified in each property. Where possible, the CDBG funds will be combined with other resources
 (eg: NYS Affordable Housing Corporation funds available through local non-profits).
- No limit is specified for the CDBG financing and grants are expected to be larger for projects that are
 approved under this program. In most cases, HUD funding will exceed the \$25,000/unit threshold in the
 Lead Paint Rule and full "abatement" will be required inside the homes. We expect to see two separate
 contracts for those properties one for the lead abatement work and one for the rehabilitation activities.
- The project area includes all communities in Jefferson County except the city of Watertown where other federal and state funding is already available to support local housing rehabilitation activities.
- Eligibility is limited to single-family owner-occupied properties with owners who qualify as low or moderate income.
- The asset test threshold has been increased to \$35,000.
- · Rental apartments will not be eligible for assistance under this program.
- Mobile homes are eligible for assistance if they are owner-occupied and located on separate lots that are
 owned by the applicant (not on leased lots in mobile home parks). Those projects are subject to strict
 limitations that were imposed by the NYS Office of Community Renewal (OCR) in new rehabilitation
 standards that were published in July 2015; and each project must be approved by OCR unless the
 existing mobile home is less than 10 years old.
- In special circumstances, CDBG funding may be used to replace an existing mobile home by purchase
 and installation of a new manufactured home. That activity can be considered if additional funding is
 available to support each project. Those will be more expensive projects that can only be accomplished
 with a combination of financing sources, perhaps including NYS-AHC and loans from USDA or private
 banks.
- Special provisions are included in the guidelines to recognize restrictions in federal and state regulations
 that would affect any work on mobile homes in sensitive environmental areas. Rehabilitation of mobile
 homes will not be permitted in flood zones or in wetlands or areas adjacent to a wetland.
- Language included to prohibit any activities in Coastal Zones or Coastal Barrier Resource Areas and to require NYS-DEC approval for any project that includes work on wells or septic systems in or adjacent to a wetland area. Those restrictions come from the environmental review process that was required for this grant.
- Releases will be required from each applicant giving the county and the NYS Housing Trust Fund
 Corporation (HTFC) the unrestricted right to use photographs taken of the property and/or the applicant
 and releasing the county and the HTFC from any liability for use of those materials.
- Before bids are solicited from local contractors, each project must be reviewed by the State Historic
 Preservation Office (SHPO), by the Tribal Historic Preservation Office (THPO) and by the DEC (for work
 in sensitive environmental areas). The THPO review is required only for projects that include ground
 disturbance (eg: for septic systems) where buried artifacts might be affected.
- Several revisions have been made in the program forms to accommodate changes in the guidelines and new requirements from the Office of Community Renewal.

COUNTY PLANNING AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Housing Program:

Staff worked with Purchasing Department to develop RFP for consultant services for the CDBG Housing program for 2019, 2020, and 2021 funding rounds. Staff participated in webinar.

North Country HOME Consortium During July and August \$70,910 in Federal HOME funds were expended; representing activity on four single family rehabs and two rental rehabs.

County Planning Board

Staff prepared materials and presented projects for the July and August Planning Board meetings.
