Whereas, The Watertown International Airport anticipates FAA funding in relation to the federal Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act, and

Whereas, These funds are available for any purpose for which airport revenues may be lawfully used in accordance with FAA Policy and Procedures Concerning Use of Airport Revenues, 64 Federal Register 7696 (64 FR 7696), as amended by 78 Federal Register 55330 (78 FR 55330), and

Whereas, Jefferson County anticipates award of \$1,091,108 which needs to be appropriated for use, and

Whereas, It is expected that the Passenger Facility Charges (PFC) collections will decrease in 2020 and likely in following years due to the world wide Coronavirus Pandemic and economic conditions as a result thereof, and

Whereas, Until such time as revenue from PFC collections return to prior levels, the CARES funds can be utilized as local shares of future State or Federal Grants or may be used for any airport purpose.

Whereas, A Project for the Replacement of Coolidge Road & CR 30 over Indian River, PIN 775359 (the "Project") is eligible for Funding under Title 23 U.S. Code, as amended, that calls for the apportionment of the costs of such program to be borne at the ratio of 80% Federal funds and 20% non-federal funds; and

Whereas, By Resolution 141 of 2017, the County of Jefferson approved the above project by making a commitment of 100% of the cost of the Preliminary Design Phases 1-4 and Right of Way Incidental of the project, and authorizing \$216,000 to cover the cost of these phases, and

Whereas, The County of Jefferson desires to advance the Project by making a commitment of 100% of the federal and non-federal share of the cost of All Phases of the project, and

Whereas, The County has allocated \$3,484,680 additionally to this project through the Adopted 2018, 2019 and 2020 Budgets, for a total of \$3,700,680.
