JEFFERSON COUNTY PUBLIC HEALTH SERVICE <u>ADVISORY BOARD/COMMITTEE SUMMARY</u>

I. HEALTH SERVICES ADVISORY BOARD

As per New York State Public Health Law Article 3, Section 357, in a county where the legislative body constitutes the Board of Health, a Health Services Advisory Board consisting of nine members shall be provided. Two of the appointed members shall be licensed physicians, while the remaining are known as public members and are selected on the basis of interest and knowledge regarding the health needs, resources and facilities of the community.

The Health Services Advisory Board counsels the Director of Public Health with respect to the discharge of powers, responsibilities and duties.

Meetings are held only if needed to address public health issues. The last meeting was held 06/14/10.

II. PROFESSIONAL ADVISORY COMMITTEE

As per NYCRR Title 10 Health Chapter V, Section 763.11 (13), the governing authority shall appoint a group of professional personnel which includes one or more physicians, registered professional nurses and representatives of the professional therapeutic services provided by the agency to perform the activities required. The findings and recommendations shall be integrated into the agency's quality assessment and assurance program. At least annually, an evaluation of the agency's program must be completed. Functions include reviewing policies pertaining to the delivery of health care and services; making recommendations on professional issues including the adequacy and appropriateness of services based on an assessment of health care resources in the community, patients' needs, available reimbursement mechanisms and the availability of qualified personnel; assisting in maintaining liaison with other health care providers and reviewing clinical records.

Quality Assurance, as a subcommittee, integrates the review activities of all home health care services provided by the agency to enhance the quality of care and treatment provided. The subcommittee reviews a sample of both active and closed clinical records to determine whether established policies are followed in furnishing services directly or under arrangement. Recommendations are made should needs be identified or if further follow-up services are required.

Required quarterly meetings are in March, June, September and December on the second Wednesday of the month at the Public Health Facility.

Briefing Summary

Contracting for Medical Examiner Autopsy Coverage

<u>Overview</u>: A medical examiner is a medically qualified physician whose duty is to investigate deaths and injuries that occur under unusual or suspicious circumstances, and to perform post-mortem examinations. The Jefferson County Medical Examiner Office investigates deaths that fall into categories as outlined in County Law Article 17A, namely instances where the public interest is served by explaining cause, manner and mechanism of death. A medical examiner has jurisdiction and authority to investigate the death of every person dying within his county, or whose body is found within the county, which is or appears to be:

- A violent death, whether by criminal violence, suicide or casualty;
- A death caused by unlawful act or criminal neglect;
- A death occurring in a suspicious, unusual or unexplained manner;
- A death caused by suspected criminal abortion;
- A death while unattended by a physician, so far as can be discovered, or where no physician is able to certify the cause of death as provided in the public health law and in form as prescribed by the commissioner of health can be found; and
- A death of a person confined in a public institution other than a hospital, infirmary or nursing home.

The Medical Examiner makes inquiries regarding all unnatural deaths within the County. An unnatural death can be defined as any death that is not the direct result of a natural, medically recognized disease process. Information is then provided, as appropriate, to individuals and other government agencies.

In 2018, the Medical Examiner's office had a total of 119 cases and 89 autopsies. In 2019, there were 151 cases and 112 autopsies. In 2020, an estimated 165 cases and 112 autopsies are to be completed. A total of 169 cases and 118 autopsies are projected for 2021.

The Jefferson County Medical Examiner's Office (JCME) currently has a contract with Onondaga County to provide autopsy coverage. However on 10/14/20, the Onondaga County Medical Examiner's Office (OCME) informed the JCME, that they would no longer be able to provide autopsy coverage until further notice due to staffing issues. Increases seen in Medical Examiner work can be attributed to the continual rise in overdose deaths in 2019 and 2020 as well as the implications of the current COVID pandemic. In addition to the rise in cases and autopsies, the M.E.'s earned leave time has to be accounted for - vacations and occasional sick leave. Allowing for the M.E.'s leave time, plus the anticipated higher numbers of cases/autopsies and the sudden discontinuance of the OCME autopsy coverage, it becomes necessary to find other entities to provide coverage.

Request: To establish an agreement between the Jefferson County Public Health Service, Pathologist and the facility they perform the autopsy.

- Dr. Dianne Vertes and UHS Wilson Medical Center in Johnson City, NY;
- Twin Tiers Pathology Associates, PC (Pathologists, Dr. James Terzian and Dr. Robert Stoppacher) and Ascension Lourdes Hospital in Binghamton, NY; and
- Forensic Medical Services (Pathologist, Dr. Michael Sikirica) and Albany Medical Center in Albany, N

for backup Medical Examiner services. These entities are assuming Medical Examiner work for other counties as well, so their availability is dependent on their current workload. Therefore, it becomes necessary to have contractual relationships with several entities. This will also be an asset for the future with ever increasing limited Pathologist resources.
