Expressing Opposition to the Closure of New York State's Watertown Correctional Facility

By Legislator:
Whereas, A provision in the 2020-21 New York State Budget gives Governor Andrew Cuomo the authority to close state prisons with at least 90 days' notice, and
Whereas, Governor Cuomo announced on December 21, 2020 that the Watertown Correctional Facility will be closed by the end of March, and
Whereas, This action was taken before an adequate assessment of safety, without notice or opportunity for community input, and
Whereas, Closure of this correctional facility will serve to condense the prison population, jeopardizing the safety of those incarcerated in and employed by the prison system, and
Whereas, Northern New York communities have been struggling financially even before the onset of COVID-19, and
Whereas, The loss of over 300 jobs and abandonment of the facility will result in ongoing negative economic impact on Jefferson County, and
Whereas, The three state prisons which have closed in the North Country in the last decade (Camp Gabriels, Lyon Mountain, and Chateaugay Correctional Facilities) have remained empty since being closed, and
Whereas, Facilities in other regions are more costly to operate and would have more real estate value for potential reuse.
Now Therefore Be It Resolved, That the Jefferson County Board of Legislators hereby expresses its strong opposition to the closure and requests that Governor Cuomo reconsider this decision, and be it further
Resolved, That a copy of this resolution be provided to Governor Cuomo, Acting DOCCS Commissioner Anthony Annucci, Senator Patty Ritchie, Assemblyman Ken Blankenbush, Assemblyman Mark Walczyk, and Assemblyman William Barclay.

Whereas, On March 3, 2020 Chapter 23 of the Laws of 2020 amended Sections 20 and 29-a of the Executive Law to permit the Governor of the State of New York to issue by executive order any directive necessary to respond to a state of emergency including disease outbreak, and
Whereas, On March 7, 2020 the Governor declared a statewide disaster emergency to address the threat that the novel coronavirus COVID-19 poses to health and welfare, and
Whereas, The overriding concern is to slow the spread of the disease as to save lives and not overwhelm the capacity and resources of the medical system in New York State, and
Whereas, The New York State state of emergency was first set to be in effect until September 7, 2020, and has been extended five times, the most recent on December 30th to be in effect until January 29, 2021, and
Whereas, The Governor has used emergency powers to execute non-emergency policy, and
Whereas, The Governor's broad response has come with great economic and social cost and has infringed on the basic freedoms of the people of Jefferson County, and
Whereas, Jefferson County is home to free and responsible people who respect their neighbors and are making sacrifices in the name of safety, and
Whereas, The separation and balance of powers is one of the most fundamental principles of our government, and
Whereas, Legislative bills S8466/A10546 have been introduced proposing to amend the Executive Law in order to restore legislative checks and balances and reinstate local authority.
Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved, That Jefferson County supports legislation such as S8466/A10546 of 2020 to restore the balance of power and reinstate local authority, and be it further
Resolved, That the citizens of this great county are urged to continue to exercise common sense, prudence and recommendations for the good of the community, and be it further
