Whereas, The Jefferson County Office for the Aging works for the establishment and expansion of programs and services which assist older persons in the areas of their most urgent needs, and is eligible to receive State and Federal funds for the purpose of providing such needed programs and services to elderly residents of Jefferson County, and
Whereas, By Resolution 224 of 2020 this Board of Legislators authorized agreements for the provision of personal care services to the elderly, and
Whereas, The Office for the Aging waiting list for personal care services has increased significantly as the agencies are less able to provide services due to staffing difficulties at current rates.
Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved, That pursuant to Section 95-a of the General Municipal Law, Jefferson County amend said agreements with the below listed parties for provision of such programs and services to elderly residents of Jefferson County and for such consideration as follows:
Personal Care Services

U.S. Care Systems, Inc. for the period June 1, 2021 through December 31, 2022 at a blended hourly rate of \$27.03 per hour for the provision of housekeeping/chore, personal care and caregiver respite services.
