

Authorizing Intergovernmental Agreement with the Town of Hounsfield for Transfer of Ownership of Culvert J033 and Amending the County Highway Map in Relation Thereto

Whereas, By Resolution 76 of 1999 this Board authorized the "Jurisdictional Road Reclassification Program" providing for the transfer of certain roads and parts thereof to the Town in which the road is located upon the recommendation of the Highway Superintendent, and
Whereas, Sections 115-b and 115-c of New York Highway Law provide the County Board of Legislators with the authority, upon the recommendation of the Highway Superintendent and pursuant to a written agreement with the governing body of a town, to remove portions of roads including culverts from the highway system upon the adoption of a resolution, and
Whereas, The Jefferson County Highway Superintendent has recommended the removal of Culvert J033 located in the Town of Hounsfield on the town road called Military Road from the County Highway System and that ownership of said culvert be transferred to the Town of Hounsfield as hereinafter set forth.
Now, Therefore, Be it Resolved, That the Chairman of the Board and the Highway Superintendent are hereby authorized to execute an intergovernmental agreement with the Town of Hounsfield to transfer ownership of Culvert J033 to the Town, and be it further

Authorizing the Implementation and Funding in the First Instance 100% of the Federal Aid and State "Marchiselli" Program Aid Eligible Costs of a Transportation Federal-Aid Project (Noble Street over West Creek) and Appropriating Funds Therefor

Whereas, A Project for Noble Street over West Creek, PIN 775377 (the "Project") is eligible for Funding under Title 23 U.S. Code, as amended, that calls for the apportionment of the costs of such program to be borne at the ratio of 80% federal funds and 20% non-federal funds, and

Whereas, By Resolution 209 of 2019, the County of Jefferson approved the above project by making a commitment of \$195,000 for the cost of the Preliminary Design and Right of Way Incidentals Phase, and

Whereas, The County of Jefferson desires to advance the Project by making a commitment of 100% of the non-federal share of the cost of the Final Design and Right of Way Acquisition of the Project, and

Whereas, The County has allocated a total of \$500,000 to this project through the Adopted 2019, 2020 and 2021 County Budgets.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved, That the Jefferson County Board of Legislators hereby authorizes the Jefferson County Treasurer to pay in the first instance 100% of the federal and non-federal share of the cost of the Final Design and Right of Way Acquisition of the Project or portions thereof, and be it further

Resolved, That the sum of \$160,300, which includes the Preliminary Engineering Phase of the Project, or so much thereof as is necessary is hereby appropriated from Account 20511300 02904 in the 2021 County Budget, and made available to cover the cost of participation in the above phase of the Project, and be it further

Resolved, That in the event the full federal and non-federal share of the costs of the project exceed the amount appropriated above, the Jefferson County Board of Legislators shall convene to appropriate said excess amount immediately upon the notification by the Chairman of the Board of Legislators thereof, and be it further

Whereas, The residents of Jefferson County have great respect, admiration, and the utmost gratitude for all of the men and women who have selflessly served their country and this community in the Armed Forces and whose contributions and sacrifices have been vital in maintaining the freedoms and way of life enjoyed by our citizens, and
Whereas, Jefferson County seeks to honor these individuals who have placed themselves in harm's way for the good of all, and who continue to serve their community as they transition to civilian life, and
Whereas, Approximately 200,000 service members transition to civilian communities annually and studies indicate from 44% to 72% of service members experience high levels of stress during transition from military to civilian life, including a high risk for suicide during their first year after military service, and
Whereas, Operation Green Light is a collaboration between the NYS Association of Counties, NYS Council of Education Associations, the NYS County Veteran Service Officers Association and the 62 counties of New York State to show support for veterans and raise awareness about the challenges they face and the resources available to assist them and their families.
Now Therefore Be It Resolved, With designation as a Green Light for Military Service County, Jefferson County hereby declares November 1 st 2021 through Veterans Day, November 11 th 2021 a time to salute and honor the service and sacrifice of our men and women in uniform transitioning from Active Service, and be it further

COUNTY PLANNING AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Housing Program:

- 2020 Award. Staff is working with the consultant to develop the Environmental Review Record to be able to request the release of the funds. Staff participated in webinars.
- -2021 Application. Staff is working with the consultant to complete the application.
