Authorizing an Intermunicipal Agreement Between the County of Jefferson and County of Oswego for the Purpose of Purchase and Maintenance of Microwave Communications Equipment for Joint Use With Emergency Communication Systems

Whereas, The Counties of Jefferson and Oswego are part of a multi-county consortium cooperating in the interconnection and sharing of technical resources for emergency communications systems in each member county, and
Whereas, Oswego County intends to improve its microwave link between Mexico and Sandy Creek by the purchase of new equipment, and said improvement will benefit Jefferson County by improving communications and system redundancy, and
Whereas, By Resolution 72 of 2019, this Board of Legislators accepted a FY18 NYS Interoperable Communications Targeted Grant, of which there is funding available for use by Oswego County to purchase and install this equipment, and
Whereas, Oswego County's system improvement will avoid Jefferson County having to make a similar investment in improving microwave communication links in the southern end of Jefferson County, and
Whereas, Intermunicipal cooperation in this matter promotes efficiency and economy for both municipalities.

COUNTY PLANNING AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Housing Program:

- 2020 Processed \$35,000 for one housing rehab project.

Staff participated in online training for the CDBG Housing program.

Staff processed \$39,462 for two housing rehab projects and admin funds.

Staff participated in online training for the HUD HOME Housing program ERR process.

County Planning Board

Clayton (T) – Site Plan Review for a cold storage building for boats.

Dexter (V) – Special Use Permit to construct a storage building for an antinue fire truck display.

Orleans (T) – Site Plan Review to renovate and reopen a vacant convenience store.

Watertown (T) – Site Plan Review to construct two storage buildings at a boat manufacturer.

General Technical Assistance

Other Geographic Information System (GIS) Tasks (not associated with projects above)

Our GIS Specialist supports planners with various projects and other County Departments. Examples include: Created three more Legislative Redistricting prospective plans with supporting maps and statistics; developed table of LATFOR populations for Jefferson County villages; produced list of proposed Southeast Agricultural District parcels with owners to send to New York State; prepared Southeast Agricultural District map series and metadata and submitted to Cornell Institute for Resource Information Sciences as required; provided list of 2020 Census populations by town for the Department of Emergency Services; reformatted the Town of Brownville zoning map and sent it to the Town; and prepared a spreadsheet of parcels with selected attributes about age and type of structures for the Village of Clayton.
