Comments: The VSA submitted 36 claims for Compensation and Pension which saw 11 decisions returned with 26K in new payments and over 47K in back pay going to local Veterans. We are steadily seeing 3-4 Veterans/Dependents a day, 4 days a week with a fifth day for administrative purposes. The PACT Act has slowed claim processing down as the claims did not start processing until EOM January 2023.
