Whereas, The residents of Jefferson County have great respect, admiration, and the utmost gratitude for all of the men and women who have selflessly served our country and this community in the Armed Forces, and whose contributions and sacrifices have been vital in maintaining the freedoms and way of life enjoyed by our citizens, and
Whereas, Jefferson County seeks to honor these individuals who have placed themselves in harm's way for the good of all, and who continue to serve their community as they transition to civilian life and become veterans, and
Whereas, Approximately 200,000 service members transition to civilian communities annually, and studies indicate from 44% to 72% of service members experience high levels of stress during transition from military to civilian life, including a high risk for suicide during their first year after military service, and
Whereas, Veterans continue to serve our community in the American Legion, Veterans of Foreign Wars, religious groups, civil service, and by helping fellow former service members, and
Whereas, Operation Green Light is a collaboration between the NYS Association of Counties, NYS Council of Education Associations, the NYS County Veteran Service Officers Association and the 62 counties of New York State to show support for veterans and raise awareness about the challenges they face and the resources available to assist them and their families.
Now Therefore Be It Resolved, With designation as a Green Light for Military Service County, Jefferson County hereby declares from November 1 st through Veterans Day, November 11 th 2023 a time to salute and honor the service and sacrifice of our veterans and men and women in uniform transitioning from active service, and be it further
Resolved, That in observance of Operation Green Light, Jefferson County will display green lights and encourages its citizens to do so as well to honor all those who helped to preserve freedom.
