Whereas, A Project for the Replacement of CR 87 (Sandy Creek Road) over Lindsey Creek, H018, PIN 775385 (the "Project") is eligible for Funding under Title 23 U.S. Code, as amended, that calls for the apportionment of the costs of such program to be borne at the ratio of 80% Federal funds and 20% non-federal funds, and

Whereas, By Resolutions 90 of 2019, 41 of 2021 and 72 of 2022, the County of Jefferson approved the above Project by making a commitment of \$1,867,622 for the cost of various phases of the project, and

Whereas, The County of Jefferson desires to advance the Project by making a commitment of 100% of the non-federal share of the cost of the Construction Phase of the Project.

Planning Department Annual Report

COUNTY PLANNING AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Housing Program

The Planning Department has two open CDBG Housing Awards. \$506,447 was disbursed between the two awards. Sixteen owner-occupied rehab projects were approved for the 2020 award and five for the 2021 award.

North Country HOME Consortium

During 2022, \$566,686 was disbursed for 26 projects and administration. Staff conducted the annual monitoring of DANC as the subrecipient.

County Planning Board

Staff presented 87 239m reviews to the Board. The CPB met both virtually and in-person during the year.

Legislative Redistricting

Staff worked with County Administration and Ad-Hoc committee to develop new legislative district boundaries based on the 2020 US Census.

Census

Staff submitted the Boundary and Annexation Survey to the Census Bureau.

Transportation

Staff meets online with the NYS Association of Metropolitan Planning Organizations Working Group quarterly.

Staff submitted an application for the 2023 5311 rural transportation grant for capital funding to purchase six buses and one year of contracted mobility management for the future County-wide public transportation system.

Staff attended a Community Input Session at JCC sponsored by VTC's Mobility Management Team to learn about the four proposed fixed routes. Public input was well received.

Worked with City of Watertown on an RFP for a County Rural Mobility Manager.

Fort Drum Compatibility Committee

Staff meets with other planners and municipal leaders in the three-county area to discuss Fort Drum-related impacts on local municipalities.

Staff made a presentation regarding Watertown International Airport and Fort Drum Compatibility within the County.

FDRLO - Advocate Drum

Staff finished compiling the inputs for the Fort Drum Tri-County Economic Impact Model to report the total economic impact of Fort Drum for FFY 2021. Includes the direct, indirect and induced monetary impact on the Tri-County Region as well as the estimated jobs generated in major SIC Code categories.

Fort Drum WayPoint 2030

Staff attended and participated in the Fort Drum WayPoint 3030 workgroup session at JCC. It included small group discussions and updates from various military and civilian staff regarding the on- and off-post developments and partnerships influencing the near- and long-term military future. Fort Drum's status and current and future trends were discussed. Infrastructure goals, local partnerships, support to training, and force modernization were topics covered.

Former Deferiet Paper Mill - Brownfield Opportunity Area

Staff participated in conference calls and a tour of the hydro facility and redevelopment area.

Broadband

Staff is working with DANC staff to develop a plan to improve service to underserved areas of the County.

Airport

Staff discussed the proposed Airport Business Park with the Town of Hounsfield and the Airport Manager for potential airport compatibility issues due to its proximity to the two runway RPZ zones.

RESOURCE AND ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT

Agriculture

8-Year Review – Staff submitted the Eight-Year Review report and updated maps for the SE Agriculture District to NYS Department of Agriculture and Markets for their review. The SE District added 2,617 acres and removed 64 acres by landowner requests. The modified district is 52,492 acres.

Annual Inclusion - Staff processed requests from two landowners to add six parcels to existing agricultural districts consisting of 672 acres.

MS4 Coalition

Staff meets with the coalition quarterly. Staff works with County Highway to complete the Annual Report.

Snowmobile Grant-in-Aid Program

Staff works with NYS OPRHP and the five local snowmobile clubs to submit necessary documentation in order for the clubs to receive funding to assist with the maintenance of their trails.

The County received \$78,948 in funds for the 2021- 2022 season.

NYS Septic System Replacement Program

Staff processed eleven applications and disbursed \$ 50,771 to homeowners to replace the failing septic systems on the St. Lawrence River, Moon Lake, Indian River, and Guffin Bay.

Responded to callers, emails, and walk-ins with requests concerning flood maps, parcels, zoning, and county map viewer.
