Whereas, By Resolution 139 of 2023 and Resolution 40 of 2022, the Board of Legislators authorized an agreements with the Jefferson County Local Development Corporation (JCLDC) and Jefferson County Industrial Development Agency (JCIDA) for the administration and operation of certain programs for the benefit of Jefferson County citizens, which include support for small businesses, local food production and processing, childcare expansion, and tourism sector enhancement, and

Whereas, JCLDC and JCIDA have requested amendments to the subrecipient agreements to retarget unused funds to identified needs, and

Whereas, The proposed amendments include:

- Extending the term of the agreements to remain in effect until December 31, 2026.
- Authority for JCLDC and JCIDA for the remainder of the contracts to reallocate remaining funds from the existing programs authorized by Resolution 139 of 2023 and Resolution 40 of 2022, focusing on the need between Jefferson County's agricultural industry, including food production, processing, and agri-tourism, upon the approval of the County Administrator.

Whereas, A lawsuit entitled Deanna LeTray vs. Jefferson County", et al., Civil Action No.

5:20-CV-1194, is pending in the United States District Court for the Northern District of New York, with plaintiff alleging certain civil rights violations by the Jefferson County defendants while being held at the Jefferson County Jail, and
Whereas, On the advice of counsel after the consideration of the documentary evidence and legal basis relating to the claim, and that a negotiated settlement is, as a matter of litigation analysis and risk management, a cost-effective alternative to full trial of the action, and
Whereas, Counsel has advised that the range of possible verdicts includes the possibility of a verdict of no cause for action, but also may include an adverse verdict in an amount which is in the discretion of the jury and which exceeds the settlement demand of the plaintiff, and
Whereas, That the substantial costs of proceeding to trial, including both the labor and opportunity costs of making senior employees of the County available throughout the trial, the costs of attorney preparation and presentation of trial, and the costs to be incurred for expert witnesses in preparing for and testifying at trial serve to offset the total cost of settlement to the County, at the same time that a settlement defines the extent of expense and removes the threat of uncapped exposure, and
Whereas, The settlement of the matter herein requires the Jefferson County Sheriff's Office to adopt a negotiated policy with respect to transgender individuals in addition to payment to Plaintiff in the amount of Seven Thousand, Five Hundred and 00/100 Dollars (\$7,500.00).
Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved, the Board of Legislators does hereby agree to enter into a settlement agreement with Plaintiff, and directs the County Attorney to execute said settlement agreement on behalf of all County Defendants as above set forth for the sum of Seven Thousand, Five Hundred and 00/100 Dollars (\$7,500.00) for purposes of settling the referenced litigation against Jefferson County

Authorizing Intergovernmental Agreement with the Town of Watertown to Exchange Ownership and Jurisdiction of County Road 67 and Culvert T025 and a portion of Old Rome Road and Culvert T002 with said Town and Amending the County Highway Map in Relation Thereto

Whereas, by Resolution 76 of 1999 this Board authorized the "Jurisdictional Road Reclassification Program" providing for the transfer of certain roads and parts thereof to the Town in which the road is located upon the recommendation of the Highway Superintendent, and
Whereas, Sections 115-b and 115-c of New York Highway Law provides the County Board of Legislators with the authority, upon the recommendation of the Highway Superintendent and pursuant to a written agreement with the governing body of a town, to remove portions of roads from the highway system upon the adoption of a resolution, and
Whereas, the Jefferson County Highway Superintendent has recommended the removal of County Road 67 and Culvert T025 which is located thereon, from the County Highway System and that ownership of said road and culvert be transferred to the Town of Watertown as hereinafter set forth.
Whereas, the Jefferson County Highway Superintendent has further recommended that Jefferson County assume ownership of a portion of Old Rome Road, which is located in the Town of Watertown, and Culvert T002 which is located thereon, as hereinafter set forth.
Now, Therefore, Be it Resolved, that the Chairman of the Board and the Highway Superintendent be and hereby are authorized to execute an intergovernmental agreement with the Town of Watertown to transfer ownership of County Road 67, including Culvert T025 and all other drainage structures located thereon (and which road commences at the intersection with Spring Valley Drive at mile marker 0.00, thence runs easterly to the intersection with New York State Route 12 at mile marker 2.73, for a total distance of 2.73 miles) to the Town, and be it further
Resolved, That upon conveyance of the above described County Road 67 and Culvert T025 to the Town of Watertown, the assets shall be deleted from the Jefferson County Highway System Map, and be it further
Resolved, That said agreement also transfer ownership of a portion of the town road called Old Rome Road located in the Town of Watertown, including Culvert T002 and all other drainage structures located thereon (and which road commences at the intersection with County Road 62 at mile marker 0.00, thence runs northerly to the Town of Watertown/Town of Hounsfield town line at mile marker 1.99, for a total distance of 1.99 miles) to the County, and be it further
