It is with pleasure that I submit the Annual Report for the Jefferson County Clerk's Office for the fiscal year January 1, 2014 through December 31, 2014.

The County Clerk's Office is a state constitutional office that is the main depositor for records created within the county. The County Clerk serves as the Clerk of the Corporation of Jefferson County., as well as a register of mortgages, deeds and all records pertaining to real property within Jefferson County. The County Clerk also serves as clerk of the Supreme and County Courts and is commissioned to not only collect all fees of the courts but to also protect, produce upon request and preserve court records. The County Clerk, in accordance with Vehicle and Traffic Law, acts as an agent for the Commissioner of the New York State Motor Vehicle Department.

The Jefferson County Clerk's Office collects and distributes monies for various state agencies. The county's share of these collections is submitted to the county treasurer on a monthly basis with a report detailing the collections.

The following pages detail the monies collected by the Jefferson County Clerk's Office and the Department of Motor Vehicle Office that are paid to the county treasurer and disbursed to different agencies throughout the state.

I would like to thank the County Legislature for their support and look forward to working with you to continue to serve the residents of Jefferson County in the most efficient and productive manner possible.

My office is open to anyone who would like to tour the County Clerk's office, and I am willing to answer any questions that you may have.

MORTGAGE TAX

- Jefferson County levies a mortgage tax of .75% of all mortgage monies. Mortgages that are refinanced are taxed on only the new money borrowed.
 - The County Clerk's Office retains \$ 160,442.83 for the fiscal year of 01/01 through 12/31. (Mtg. Tax Expense) to defray the cost of salaries for county clerk employees to collect and distribute this money. This amount is paid monthly to the county treasurer.
 - 1/4 of 1% minus the clerk fee detailed above is paid to the New York State Mortgage Agency (SONYMA) on a monthly basis.
 - 1/2 of 1% minus the clerk fee detailed above is paid to the County Treasurer monthly. Twice a year, the treasurer presents the legislature with a resolution to disburse these monies to the towns where the mortgaged properties are located.

DEPARTMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLES

The Jefferson County Clerk acts as an agent for the Commissioner of the Department of Motor Vehicles. New York State supplies the county motor vehicle office with computer equipment, support, and all necessary forms and literature to run the DMV on behalf of the state. The county supplies the facility and the manpower to perform DMV transactions. In exchange, the county retains 12.7% of many transactions performed at the county DMV. In addition, the county is allowed to retain \$1.00 for each of the first 5,000 transactions in which sales tax has been collected for NYS. After the initial 5,000 transactions, the county is allowed to retain \$.75 per transaction.

NOTARY RENEWALS AND ORIGINAL FILINGS

The Jefferson County Clerk's Office not only offers free notary services, but also maintains the records and signatures of all notaries commissioned by the state who reside in Jefferson County.

The fee for filing notifications of appointments of new notaries is \$60.00. This fee is paid to the Department of State by the applicant and the NYSDOS pays \$20.00 of the fee to the County Clerk's Office with each new filing.

Notifications for renewals of notary licenses are sent by the County Clerk's Office to each notary in Jefferson County that is eligible for renewal. The County Clerk collects \$60.00 for each four year renewal. The county retains \$20.00 and \$40.00 for each renewal is sent to the NYS Department of State each month.

TRANSFER TAX

All transfers of interest of Real Property require the filing of the NYS Form called TP-584. This form must be submitted for any transfer of interest in Real Property including Deeds, Boundary Line Agreements, Right of Ways, Easements and many others. If there is a value gained by this transfer and no exemption is claimed, the County Clerk's Office collects transfer tax for the state. The county is paid \$6.00 for each TP-584 form submitted unless the transfer is exempt from payment. The following are fees collected for the county and for the state associated with the TP-584. Payment for this tax is made to the Commissioner of Taxation and Finance.

RP-5217 REPORT

For each parcel to be transferred properly, NYS Real Property Law mandates that a form, the RP-5217, be submitted that contains certain information pertinent to the transfer. This information includes the type of parcel being transferred (EX: agricultural or residential, etc.), addresses of seller and buyer, parcel number, etc.

The fee retained by the county is \$9.00 for each form. The fee sent to the state is either \$116.00 or \$241.00 depending upon how the parcel is classified. Listed below are monies collected and paid to the Commissioner of Taxation and Finance, and the amount of fees collected for the county.

NYS COMMISSIONER OF EDUCATION AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT RECORDS MANAGEMENT FUND

For every record recorded in the County Clerk's Office, there is a \$20.00 fee added to the other recording fees in compliance with NYS Civil Practice Law and Rules. This fee was established with the intention that records that must be maintained permanently should generate revenue to pay for their preservation. The portion of the fee sent to the Local Governments Records Management Fund, LGRMIF, is meant to be returned to municipalities through State Archives grants.

The \$20.00 fee for all recordings is divided as follows:

- \$14.75—NYS Education Department
- \$ 4.25—Local Governments Records Management Fund
- \$1.00—County

COURTS

The County Clerk's Office is the repository for all documents submitted to the Supreme and County Courts, both Civil and Criminal, and is responsible for the preservation and production upon request of these documents. The County Clerk's Office also acts as treasurer for the courts. All fees for the submission of papers, fines and surcharges are collected by the clerk's office.
