REPORT OF THE BOARD OF ELECTIONS - 1958

To the Honorable Board of Supervisors of the County of Jefferson:

In accordance with Section 34 of the Election Law, we herewith submit the following report for the year 1958:

The 1957 registration of 10,071 in the City of Watertown and the vote in the towns of 15,764 resulted in an enrollment of 25,826 voters. Instead of printing the enrollments as had been done in the past, lists of enrolled voters were made by IBM and Multilith machines and the lists, by districts, collated by the Board of Elections for distribution. The 1958 enrollment by parties was as follows:

A total of 639 persons registered centrally, an increase over 1957 of 171. Registrations by persons confined by illness or physical disability or out of the state on business totaled 34, registrations by servicemen and their dependents 186 and hospitalized veterans 4. Absentee ballots mailed out totaled 610, of which 424 were regular absentee and 168 military. Of this number, 372 regular absentee and 151 military ballots were returned in time to be canvassed.
