

REPORT OF THE BOARD OF ELECTIONS - 1963

To the Honorable Board of Supervisors:

We herewith submit the following report for the year 1963:

The Party Enrollment for use at the 1963 Primary Election was as follows:

A Primary Election was held on September 5, 1963 for the offices of Mayor and City Councilmen in the City of Watertown on a non-partisan basis and in the towns of Adams, Alexandria, Brownville, Clayton, Hounsfield, Lorraine, Pamela, Rodman, Rutland, Theresa and Fourth Ward, City of Watertown in the Republican Party for local offices.

Registration

Central Registration ^{for voters} living in the non-personal districts commenced on May 1 and continued through September 20, with 109 being registered. In the City of Watertown under the second year of Permanent Personal Registration 251 voters were registered during Central Registration. A routine mail check of voters under the Permanent Personal Registration system was made in September. Cancellation of registrations due to moving, death and felony convictions totaled approximately 1200. The final 1963 registration was:
