Resolution 19-13 Approval of Youth & Young Adult Work Experience Policy

Whereas, WIOA section 129(c)(2)(c) and 20 CFR 681.600 addresses work experience as a learning experience that takes place in a workplace for a limited time period. Work Experience may be paid or unpaid as appropriate. Work experience may take place in a public or private sector business,

Whereas, labor standards must apply,

Whereas, the work experience must provide the youth with opportunities for career exploration and skill development;

Whereas, the work experience must include academic and occupational education to enhance a trainee's prospects for long-term labor market attachment;

Therefore be resolved that the Jefferson-Lewis Workforce Development adapts the Youth and Young Adult Work Experience Policy.
