Approval of the Reasonable Accommodations Policy

Whereas, this policy is based on the provisions of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 as amended by the Americans with Disabilities Amendment Act; the Rehabilitation Act of 1973; Chapter 49.60 of the Revised Code of Washington; and Executive Order 96-04.
