COVID-19 Vaccination Clinics for Businesses Offered

May 18, 2021~Watertown, NY~ The Jefferson County Public Health Service (JCPHS) is now offering on-site COVID-19 vaccination clinics to Jefferson County businesses. Businesses can sign up a group of ten or more people (age 18+) and the JCPHS will bring the vaccines directly to your location.

The online form can be filled out at www.jcphs.org. JCPHS will then contact you to schedule a clinic at your location. Employees will receive [Moderna vaccine](#) that will require a second dose clinic to be scheduled 28 days after the first dose clinic. All vaccinations require at least a 15-minute observation period afterwards to monitor for any allergic reactions.

You can help protect yourself and the people around you by getting vaccinated.
